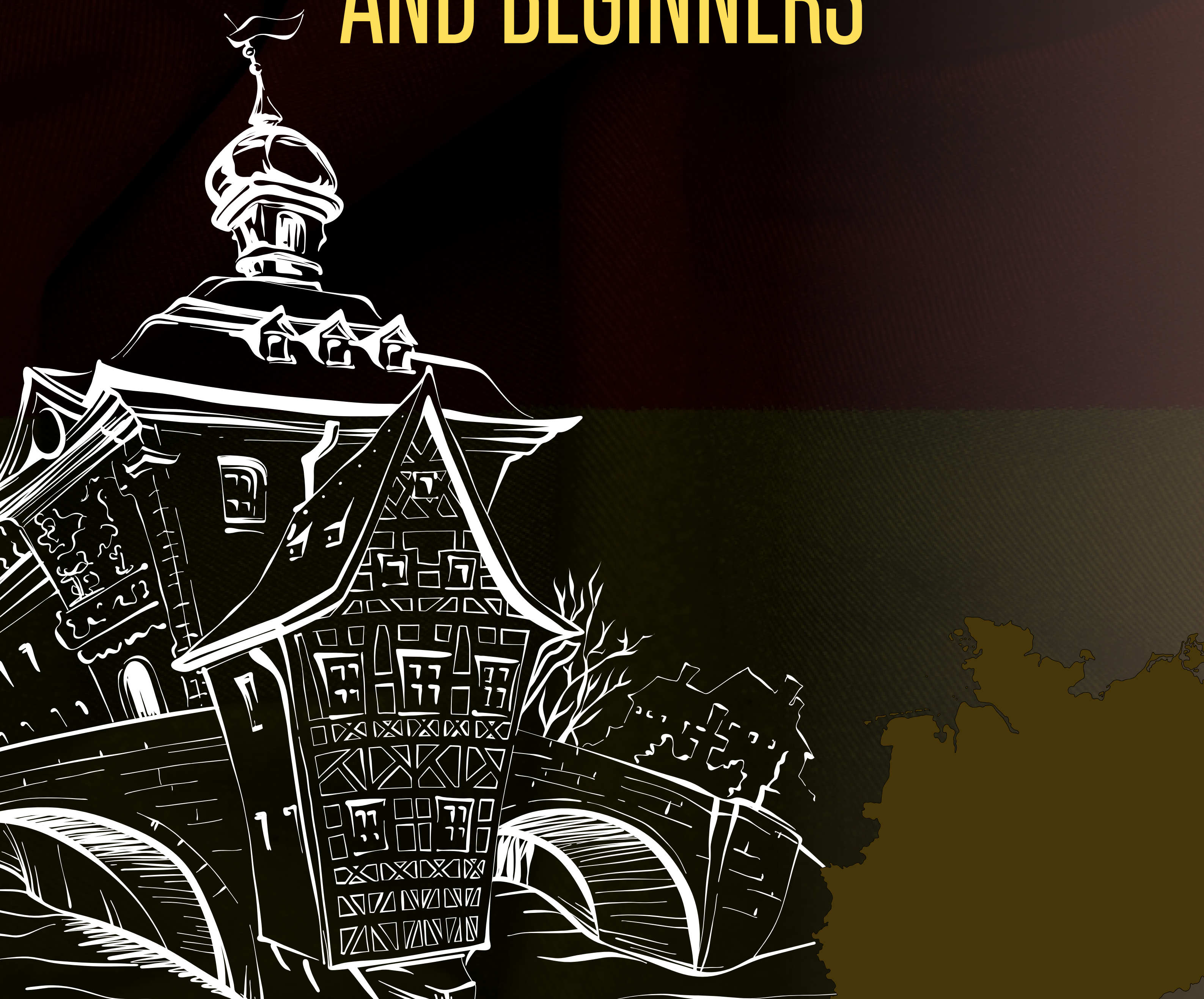

ESSENTIAL GREETINGS AND POLITE EXPRESSIONS

Basic Greetings:

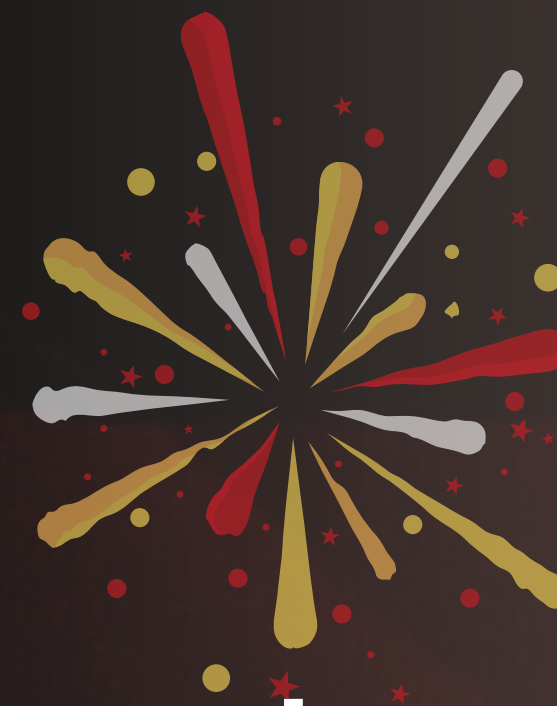
- "Hallo" – Hello (informal)
- "Guten Tag" – Good day (formal)
- "Guten Morgen" – Good morning
- "Guten Abend" – Good evening
- "Tschüss" – Bye (informal)
- "Auf Wiedersehen" – Goodbye (formal)

Politeness Phrases:

- "Bitte" – Please
- "Danke" – Thank you
- "Danke schön" – Thank you very much
- "Entschuldigung" – Excuse me / Sorry
- "Es tut mir leid" – I'm sorry



ASKING FOR HELP AND DIRECTIONS



Common Questions:

- "Sprechen Sie Englisch?" – Do you speak English? (formal)
- "Können Sie mir helfen?" – Can you help me?
- "Wo ist die Toilette?" – Where is the bathroom?
- "Wie komme ich zum Bahnhof?" – How do I get to the train station?
- "Ist es in der Nähe?" – Is it nearby?

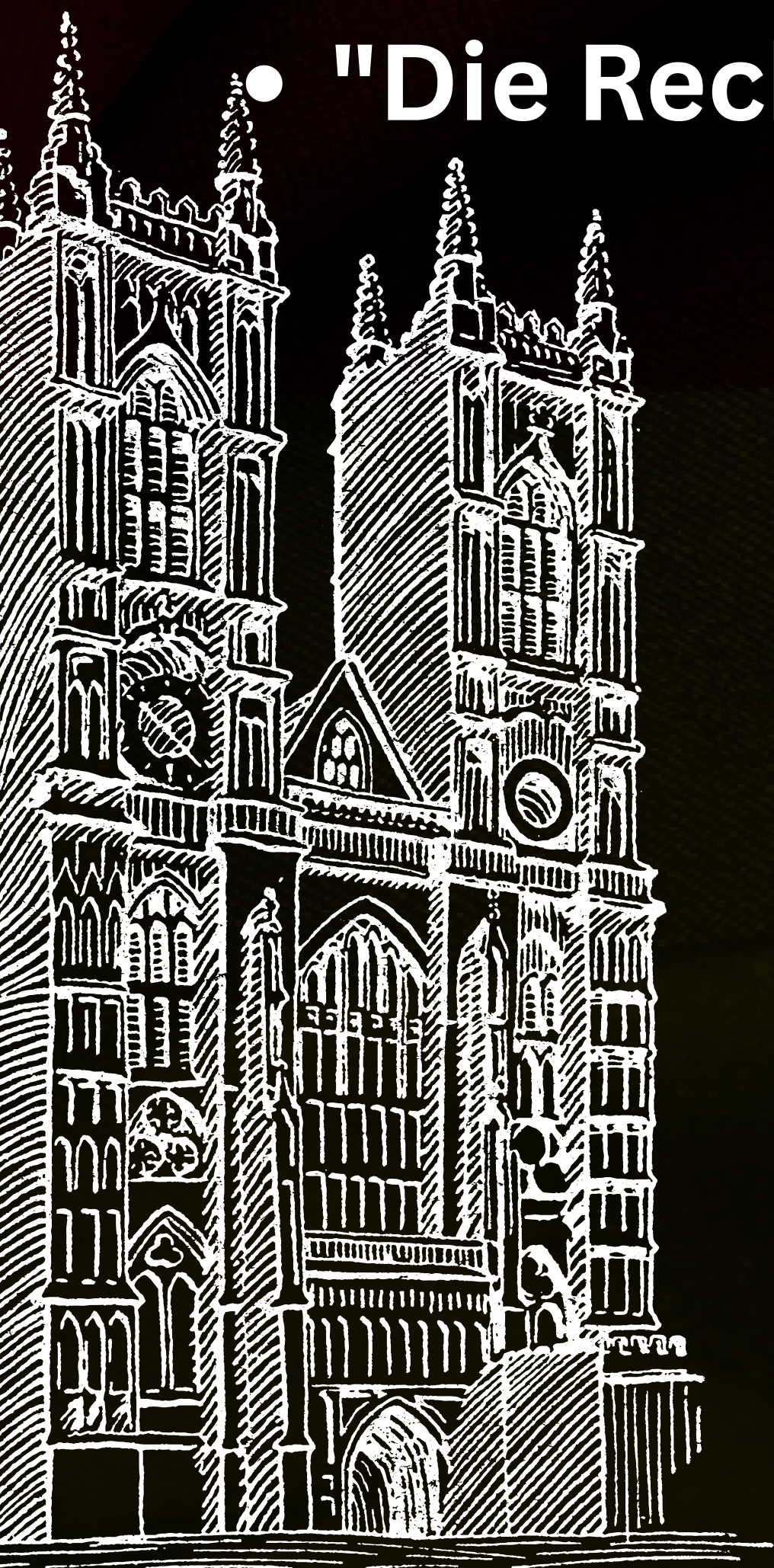




ORDERING FOOD AND DRINKS

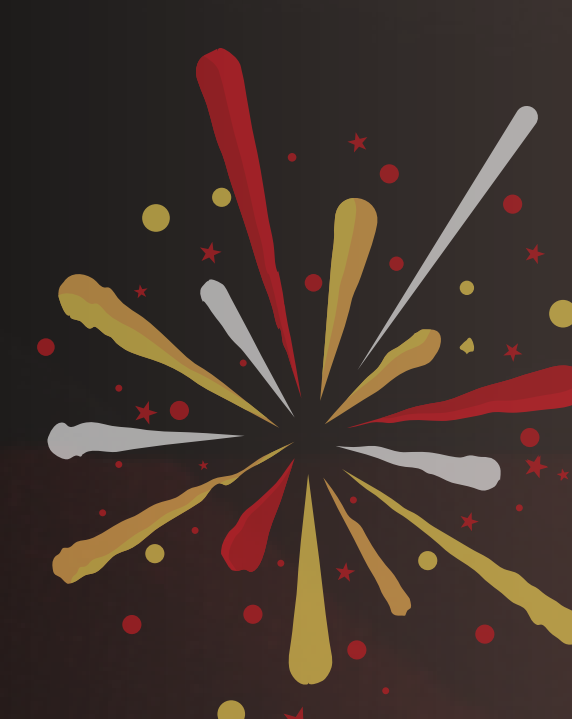
Basic Phrases for Restaurants:

- "Ich hätte gerne..." – I would like...
- "Die Speisekarte, bitte." – The menu, please.
- "Was empfehlen Sie?" – What do you recommend?
- "Ich bin Vegetarier(in)." – I am vegetarian
- "Die Rechnung, bitte." – The check, please



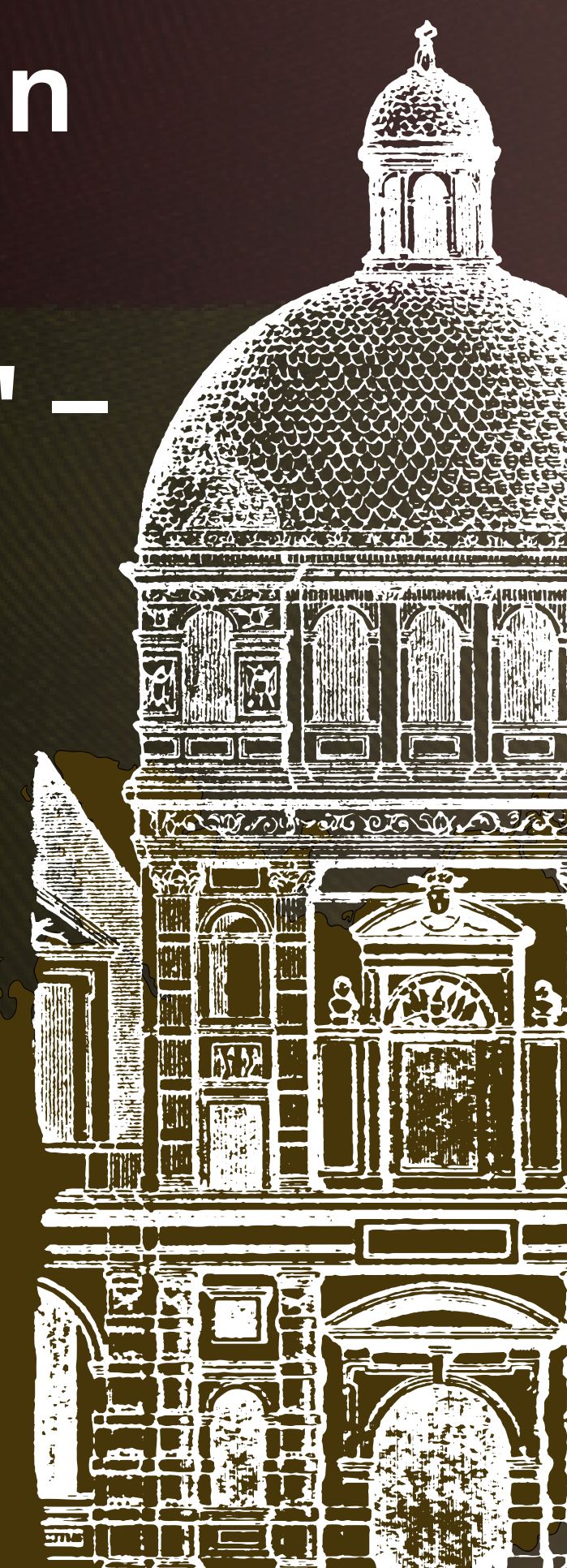


TRANSPORTATION AND GETTING AROUND



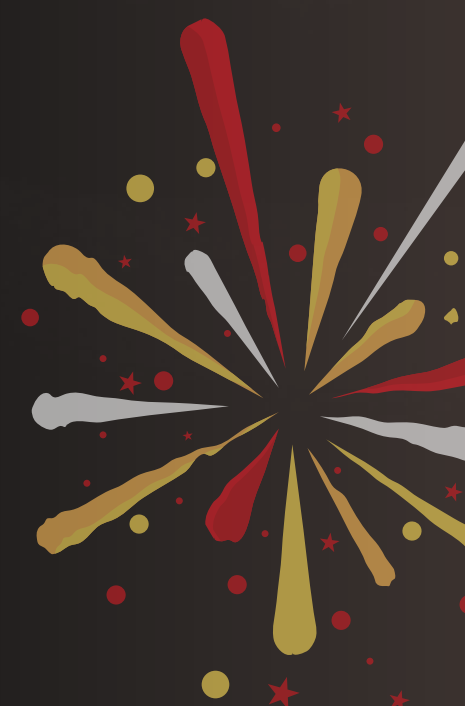
Useful Transportation Phrases:

- "Ein Ticket nach Berlin, bitte." – A ticket to Berlin, please.
- "Wann fährt der nächste Zug?" – When does the next train leave?
- "Gibt es eine U-Bahn-Station in der Nähe?" – Is there a subway station nearby?
- "Wie komme ich zum Flughafen?" – How do I get to the airport?



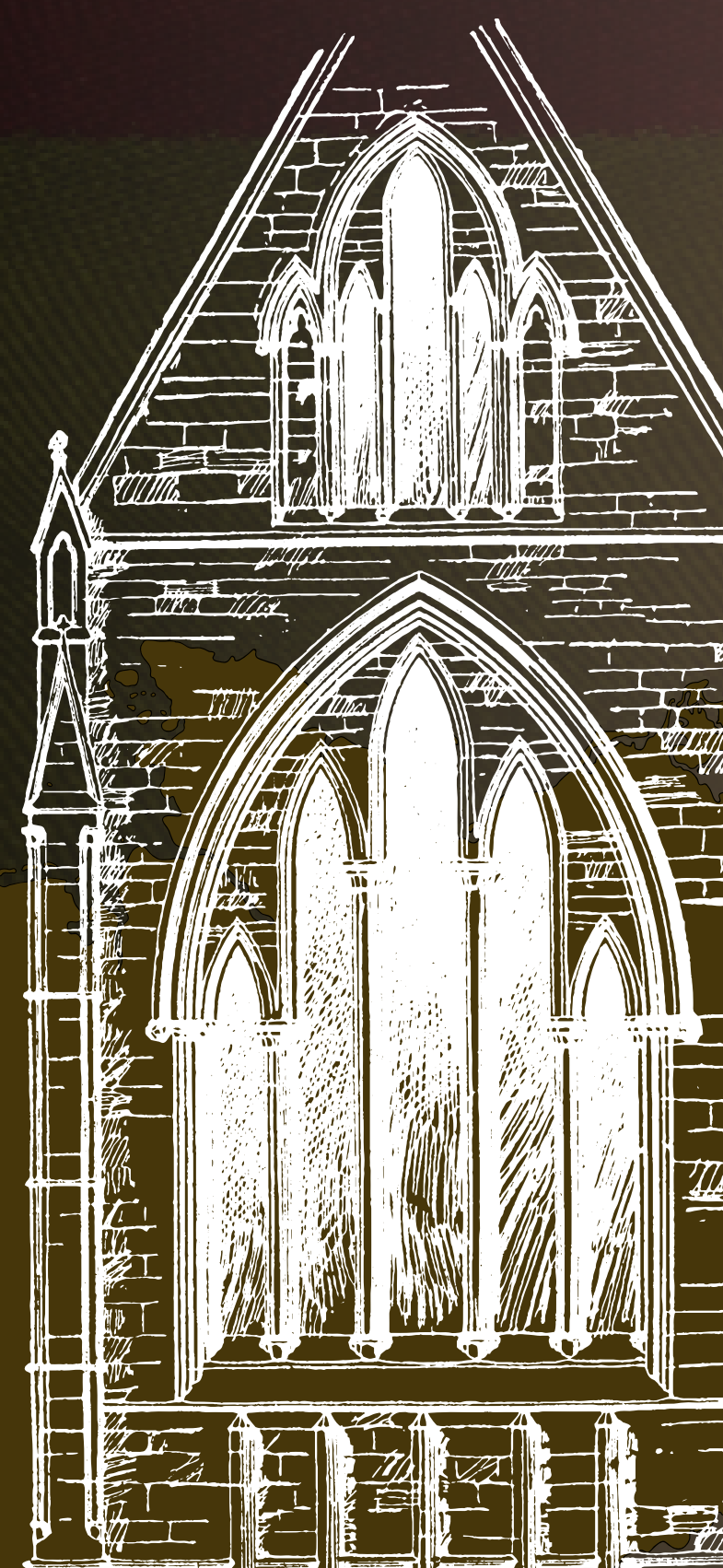


EMERGENCY SITUATIONS



Important Emergency Phrases:

- "Hilfe!" – Help!
- "Rufen Sie die Polizei!" – Call the police!
- "Ich brauche einen Arzt." – I need a doctor.
- "Ich habe meine Tasche verloren." – I lost my bag.
- "Gibt es eine Apotheke in der Nähe?" – Is there a pharmacy nearby?
