

- ✓ Thank you → Grazie!
- ✓ You're welcome → Prego!
- ✓ Excuse me / Sorry → Mi scusi (formal) / Scusa (informal)
- Cultural Tip: Italians use "Ciao" for both hello and goodbye, but it's informal. Use Buongiorno or Buonasera in professional or polite settings.

- Dove posso prendere un taxi? → Where can I get a taxi?
- Mi può portare a...? → Can you take me to...?
- Quanto costa per andare a...? → How much does it cost to go to...?
- Dove si trova la fermata dell'autobus? → Where is the bus stop?
- A che ora parte il treno? → What time does the train leave?

#### Buying Tickets & Asking for Directions

- Vorrei un biglietto per... → I'd like a ticket to...
- Quanto costa un biglietto? → How much is a ticket?
- Mi può aiutare? → Can you help me?
- Dove si trova il museo/il ristorante/l'albergo? → Where is the museum/restaurant/hotel?
- A destra / A sinistra → To the right / To the left
- Sempre dritto → Straight ahead


### SHOPPING & HANDLING MONEY

- Quanto costa? → How much does it cost?
- Posso pagare con la carta di credito? → Can I pay by credit card?
- Avete questo in un'altra taglia? → Do you have this in another size?
- Mi fa uno sconto? → Can you give me a discount?

- Ho bisogno di un dottore. → I need a doctor.
- Dove si trova l'ospedale? → Where is the hospital?
- Mi sono perso/a. → I am lost.
- Mi hanno rubato il portafoglio! → My wallet has been stolen!
