# STRUCTURE OF A TURKISH ESSAY

A well-written essay follows this format:

- Giriş (Introduction) → Present your main idea (Ana fikir)
- 2 Gelişme (Body Paragraphs)  $\rightarrow$  Support your thesis with arguments  $\delta$  examples
- 3 Sonuç (Conclusion) → Summarize & provide a final thought

### **Useful Turkish Connectors**& Transition Words

- FOR INTRODUCING AN ARGUMENT:
- ✓ ÖNCELIKLE FIRSTLY
- ✓ HER ŞEYDEN ÖNCE BEFORE EVERYTHING ELSE
- FOR GIVING EXAMPLES:
- ✓ ÖRNEĞIN FOR EXAMPLE
- ✓ MESELA FOR INSTANCE
- FOR CONTRASTING IDEAS:
- ✓ ANCAK / FAKAT HOWEVER
- ✓ ÖTE YANDAN ON THE OTHER HAND
- FOR CONCLUSIONS:
- ✓ SONUÇ OLARAK IN CONCLUSION
- ✓ ÖZETLEMEK GEREKIRSE TO SUMMARIZE
- **\*** EXAMPLE SENTENCE:

ÖRNEĞIN, ŞEHIRDE YAŞAMAK DAHA FAZLA IŞ FIRSATI SUNARKEN, KIRSAL ALANLAR DAHA HUZURLU BIR YAŞAM SAĞLAR.

(FOR EXAMPLE, LIVING IN THE CITY OFFERS MORE JOB OPPORTUNITIES, WHILE RURAL AREAS PROVIDE A MORE PEACEFUL LIFE.)

## Common Writing Mistakes to Avoid

- **NISTAKE #1: MIXING FORMAL & INFORMAL LANGUAGE**
- ✓ WHY IT'S A PROBLEM:

TURKISH HAS FORMAL (RESMI) AND INFORMAL (GÜNLÜK) REGISTERS, AND MIXING THEM IN AN ESSAY MAKES WRITING SOUND UNNATURAL AND INCONSISTENT.

- ✓ HOW TO FIX IT:
- ✓ USE FORMAL EXPRESSIONS INSTEAD OF CONVERSATIONAL ONES.
- AVOID SLANG OR COLLOQUIAL WORDS (KANKA, AYNEN, FALAN).
- ✓ USE "SIZ" INSTEAD OF "SEN" IN ACADEMIC OR BUSINESS WRITING.
- **\*** EXAMPLE:
- X BU KONUYU ANLATMAYA ÇALIŞACAĞIM ÇÜNKÜ ÇOK ÖNEMLI. (CASUAL)
- ☑ BU KONU ELE ALINACAKTIR ÇÜNKÜ OLDUKÇA ÖNEMLIDIR. (FORMAL)

## Common Writing Mistakes to Avoid

- **MISTAKE #2: OVERUSING SHORT SENTENCES**
- ✓ WHY IT'S A PROBLEM:

SHORT, CHOPPY SENTENCES MAKE WRITING SOUND UNNATURAL AND SIMPLISTIC. ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL TURKISH WRITING PREFERS COMPLEX SENTENCE STRUCTURES WITH TRANSITION WORDS.

- ✓ HOW TO FIX IT:
- COMBINE SHORT SENTENCES USING TRANSITION WORDS (ÇÜNKÜ, AYRICA, DOLAYISIYLA, BU YÜZDEN).
- USE RELATIVE CLAUSES TO EXPAND SENTENCES.
- **\*** EXAMPLE:
- X İNTERNET ÇOK YAYGIN. ÇOĞU KIŞI KULLANIYOR. HAYATIMIZI DEĞIŞTIRDI. (TOO SHORT)
- ☑ İNTERNET, ÇOĞU KIŞININ KULLANDIĞI VE HAYATIMIZI ÖNEMLI ÖLÇÜDE DEĞIŞTIREN BIR TEKNOLOJIDIR. (MORE NATURAL)

## Common Writing Mistakes to Avoid

- **MISTAKE #3: FORGETTING CASE SUFFIXES (-I, -E, -DEN, ETC.)**
- ✓ WHY IT'S A PROBLEM:

TURKISH USES CASE SUFFIXES INSTEAD OF PREPOSITIONS (LIKE "TO" OR "FROM" IN ENGLISH). OMITTING THEM LEADS TO UNCLEAR SENTENCES.

- ✓ HOW TO FIX IT:
- ✓ LEARN THE SIX TURKISH CASES:
- 1 -I (ACCUSATIVE CASE) → KITABI OKUDUM. (I READ THE BOOK.)
- 2 -E (DATIVE CASE) → ARKADAŞIMA MESAJ YAZDIM. (I TEXTED MY FRIEND.)
- 3 -DE (LOCATIVE CASE) → EVDEYIM. (I'M AT HOME.)
- 4 -DEN (ABLATIVE CASE) → İSTANBUL'DAN GELDIM. (I CAME FROM ISTANBUL.)
- 5 -ILE (INSTRUMENTAL CASE) → KALEMLE YAZIYORUM. (I'M WRITING WITH A PEN.)
- 6 -IN (GENITIVE CASE) → ALI'NIN ARABASI VAR. (ALI HAS A CAR.)
- **\*** EXAMPLE:
- X BU KITAP ÇOK GÜZEL, DÜN KÜTÜPHANE ALDIM. (WRONG)
- ☑ BU KITAP ÇOK GÜZEL, DÜN KÜTÜPHANEDEN ALDIM. (CORRECT)
- ✓ TIP: READ TURKISH NEWSPAPERS, ACADEMIC ARTICLES, AND ESSAYS TO IMPROVE YOUR FORMAL WRITING SKILLS!
